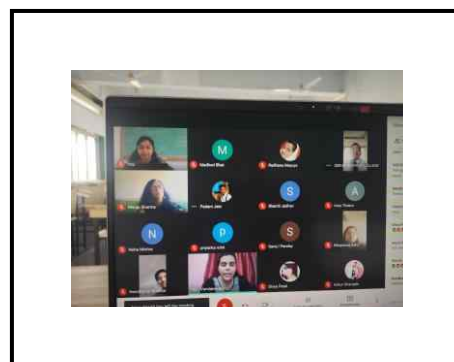
Teachers Day Celebration – 5th Sept. 2020

teacher's day celebration program was held on 5th September. The program started at 10:15 am in online mode through Google meet app.

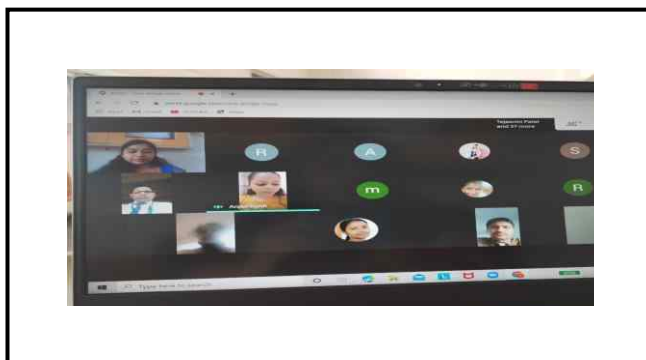

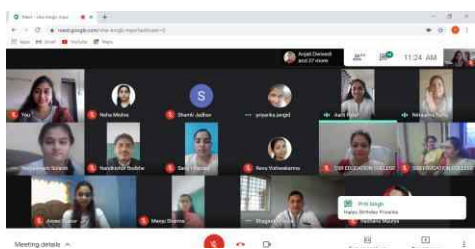
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jain, Tanvi came up with slide which had some slogans said by Gandhiji. These posters were made by Madhuri. K. and Tanvi

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Navratri & Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam Birth Anniversary – 17th Oct. 2020

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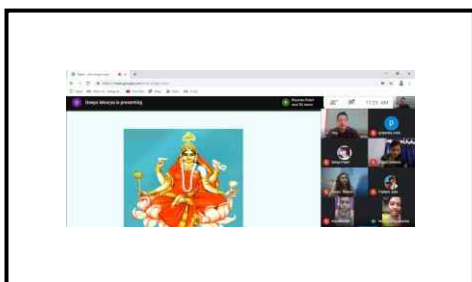
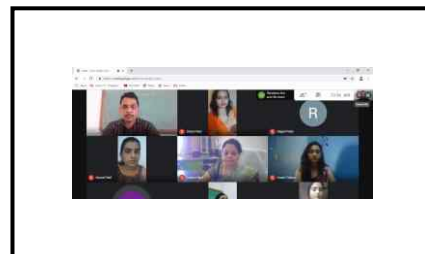
On the occasion of birth anniversary of an Indian aerospace scientist who served as the [11th President of India](#), Dr. A.P. J.
